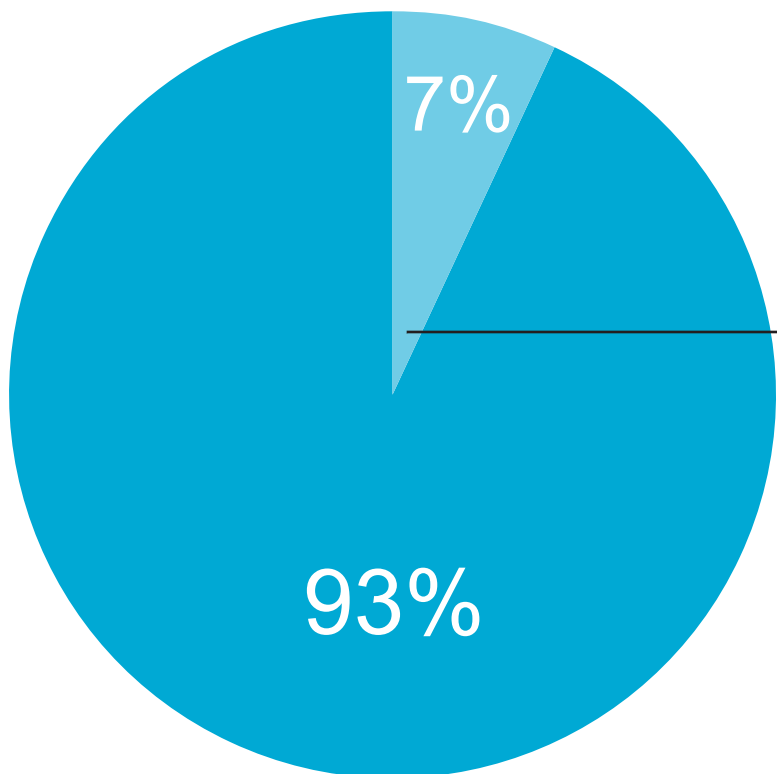




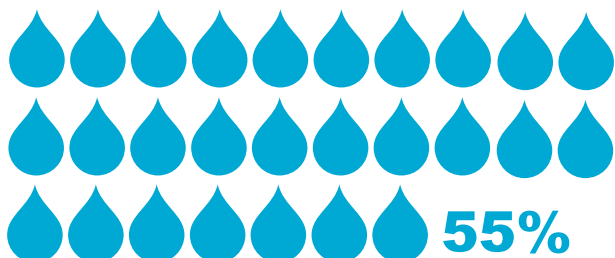

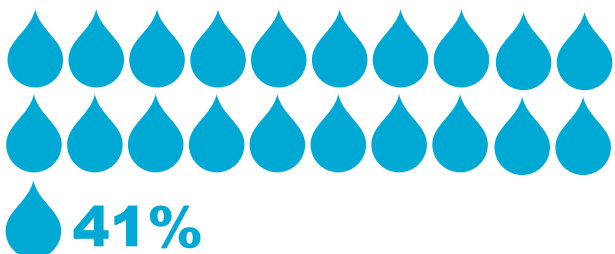
COLUMBIA RIVER WATER

SB 190: THE COLUMBIA RIVER FAIR SHARE ACT

SB 190 WOULD ALLOW OREGON FARMERS TO ACCESS MORE OF THEIR SHARE OF EXCESS COLUMBIA RIVER WATER TO IRRIGATE DRY EASTERN OREGON FARMLAND. MORE COLUMBIA RIVER WATER WOULD CREATE AN OASIS IN EASTERN OREGON AND SPUR AN AGRICULTURAL RENAISSANCE. SB 190 SIMPLY **INCREASES FROM 0.3% TO 0.6%** THE AMOUNT OF COLUMBIA RIVER WATER THAT OREGON CAN PUT TO USE.
