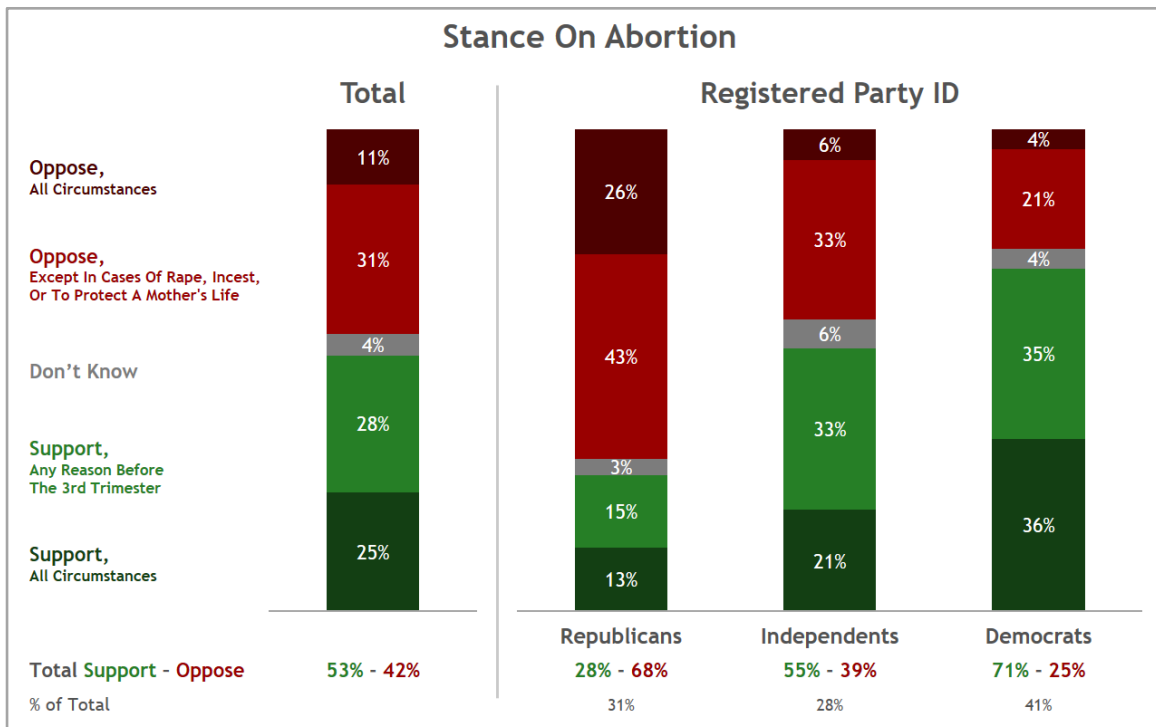

SUBJECT: OREGON STATEWIDE SURVEY RESULTS
DATE: FEBRUARY 8, 2018

Ragnar Research Partners has summarized for Oregon Right To Life the key metrics of a survey conducted by Ragnar Research. This poll surveyed 500 Likely General Election Voters (LVs) across Oregon statewide. Interviews were conducted January 28-29, 2018 by telephone, including landlines and cell phones. The margin of error for this study is $\pm 4\%$.

A Majority Support Some Level Of Restriction On Abortion

Overall, 42% are opposed to abortion in most circumstances compared to 53% who support abortion in most circumstances. One in 10 voters are opposed to abortion under all circumstances (11%) and 31% in all but the most extreme circumstance, such as protecting the mother’s life. Of the slight majority who support abortion (53%), over half do not support it during the third trimester (28%).

Question: Please tell me which of the following best represents your views on abortion. Do you (ROTATE) support abortion under all circumstance, support abortion for any reason before the third trimester, oppose abortion except in cases of rape, incest, or to protect the life of the mother, or oppose abortion under all circumstances?

Bottom Line

Not surprisingly, a majority of likely voters in Oregon lean center-left. However, despite the pro-life stance typically being a part of the conservative platform, most Oregonians support at least some restrictions on abortion and just under half oppose it in all circumstances or all but the most extreme circumstances.
